

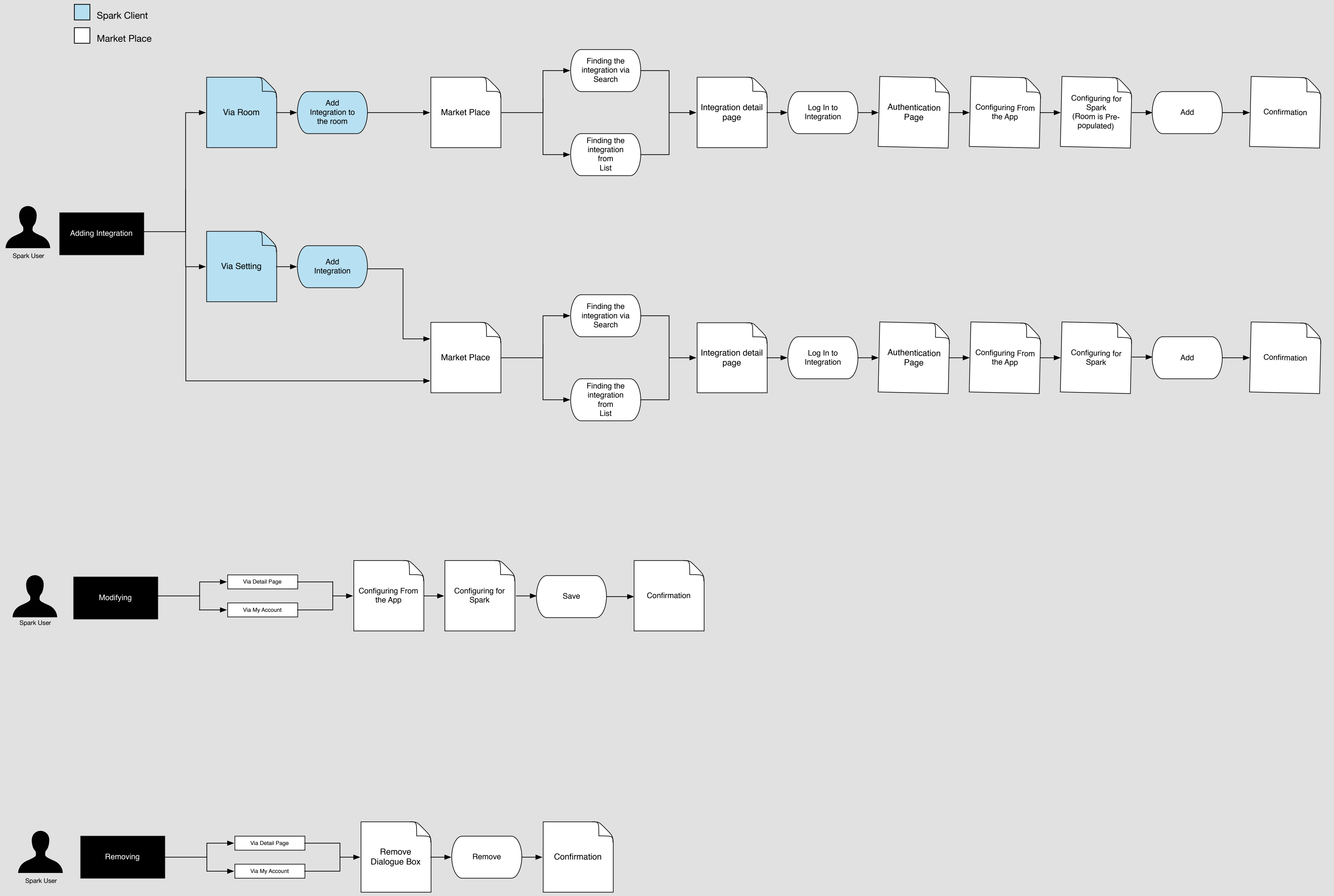

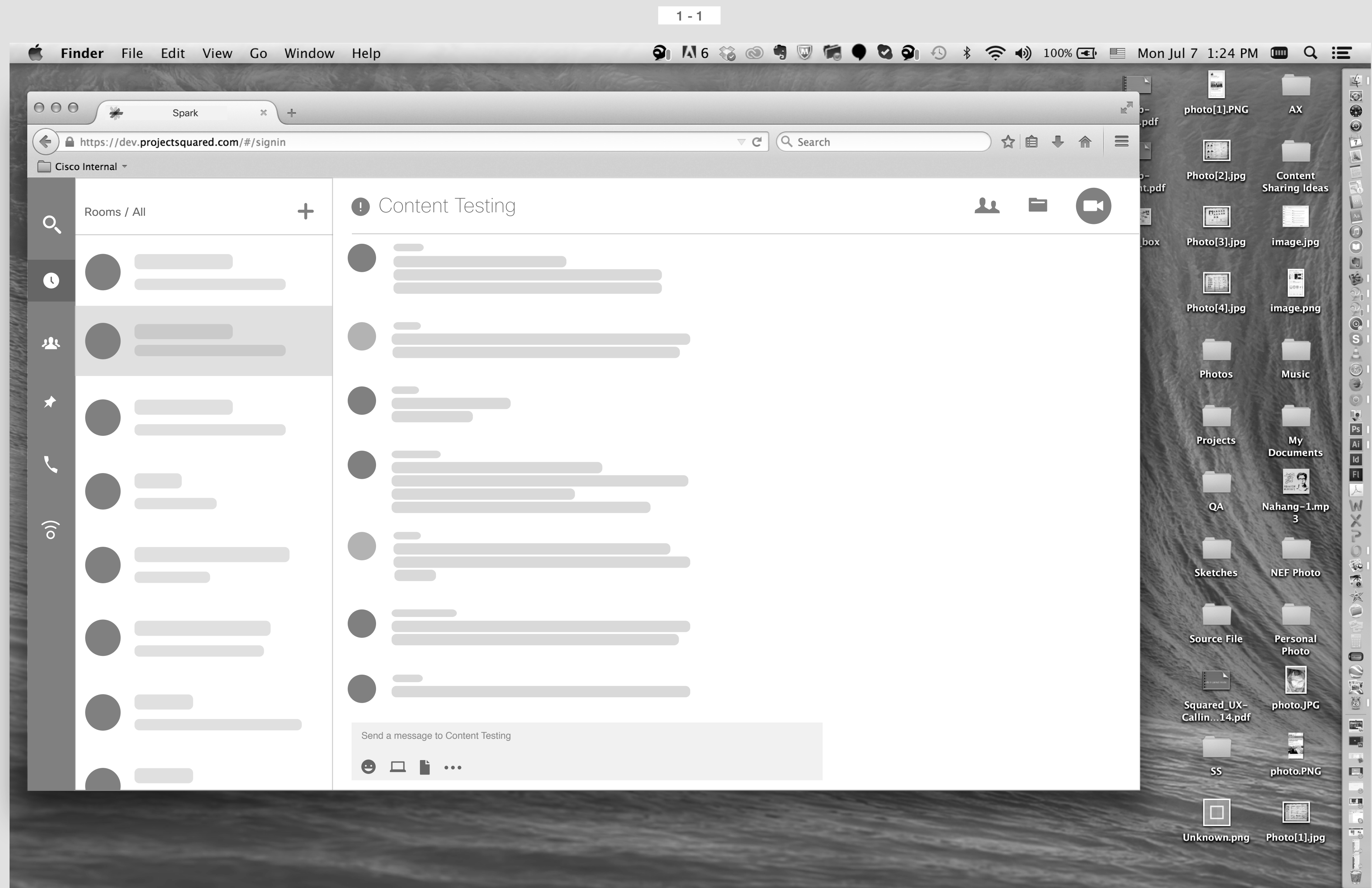

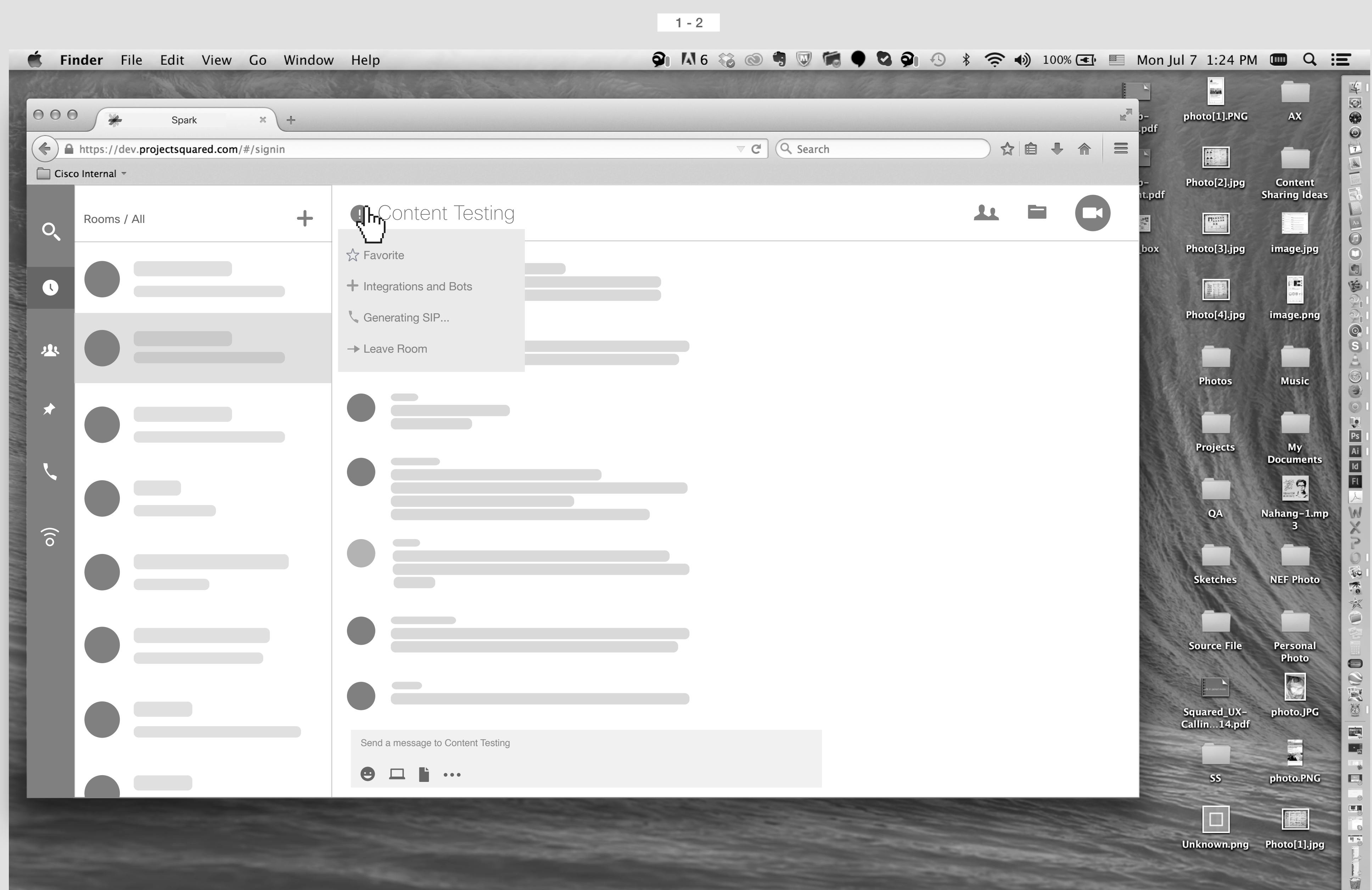


Adding an Integration

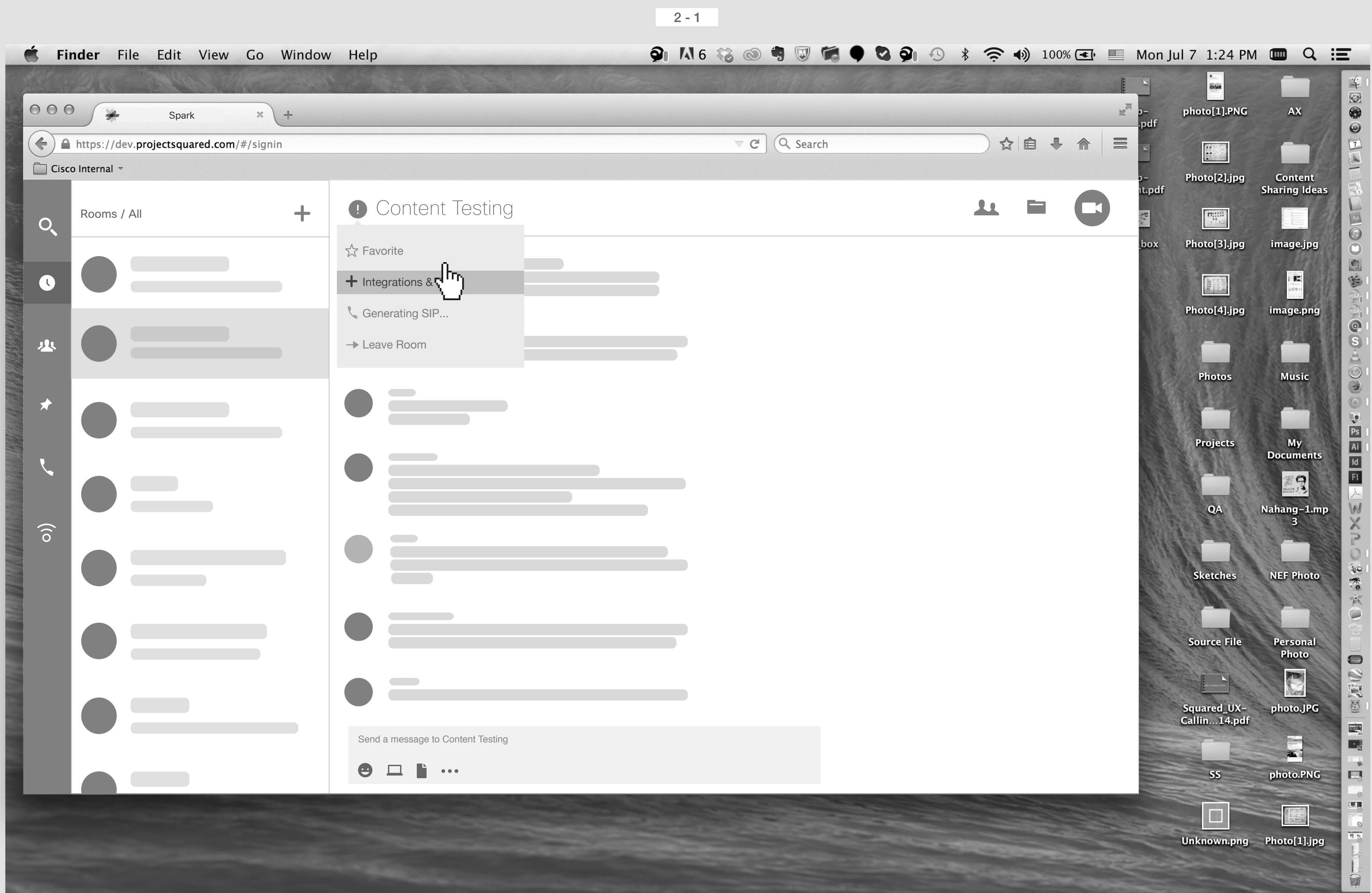

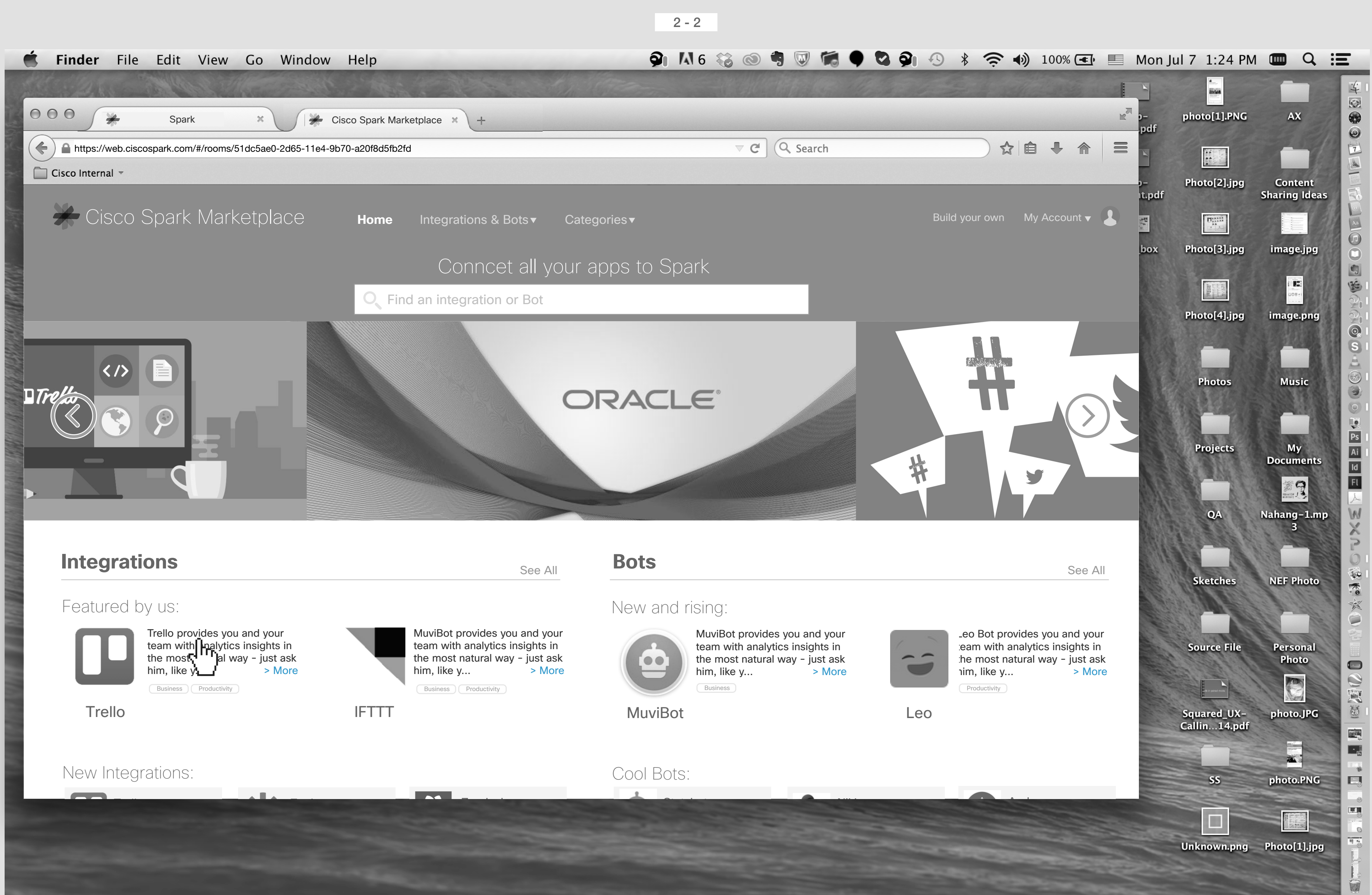

She clicks on info icon.



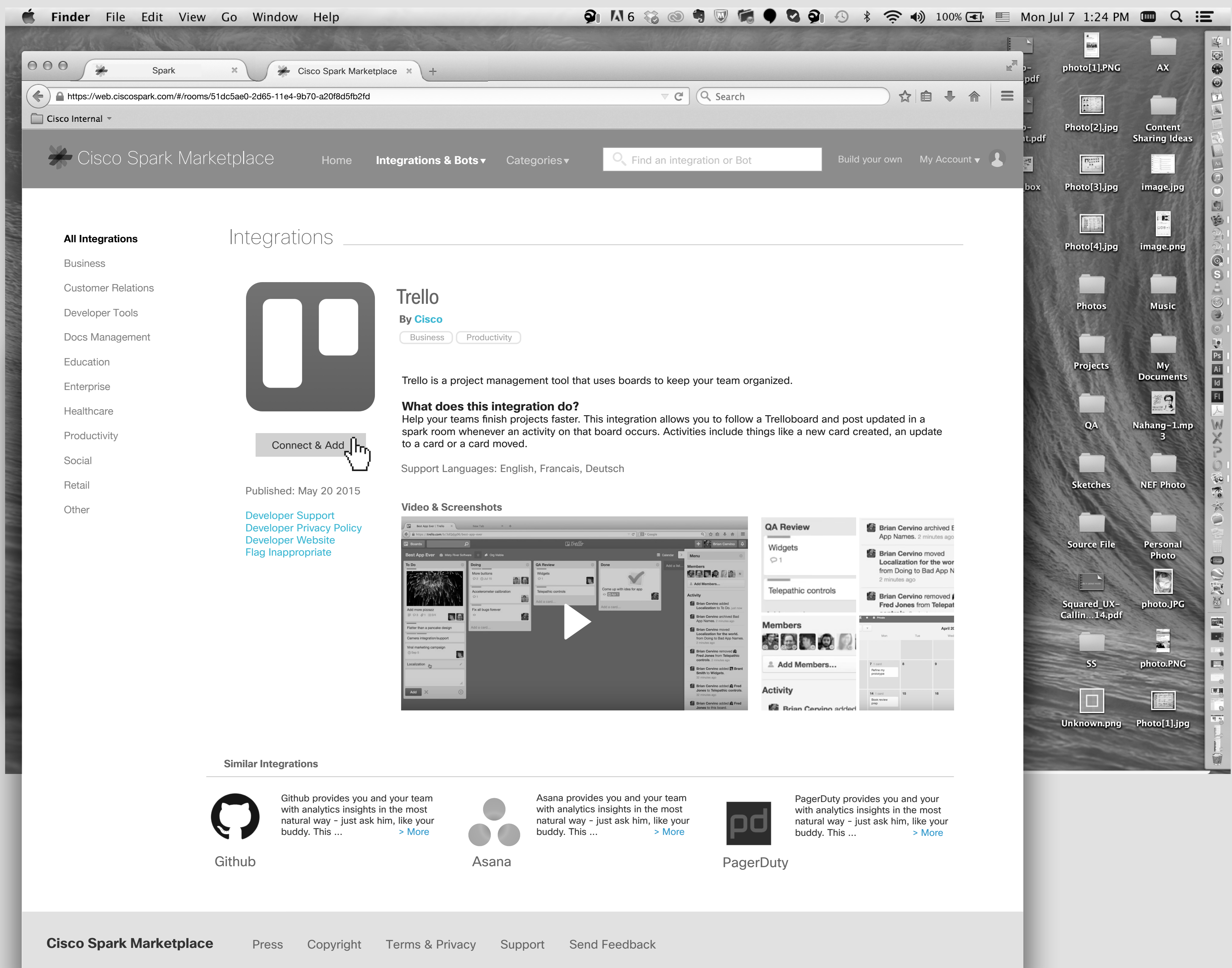
She clicks on “Add Integrations & Bots”.

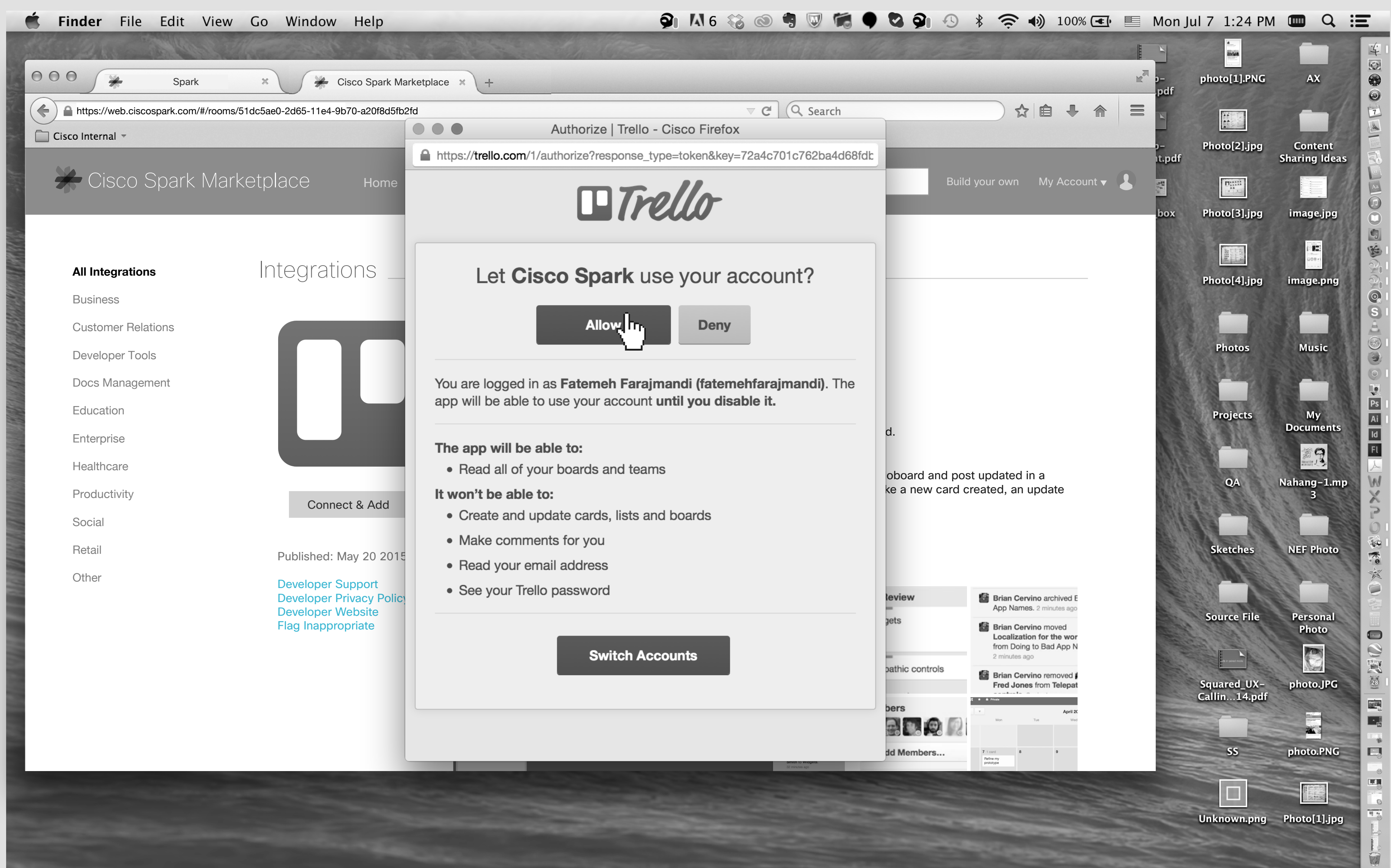

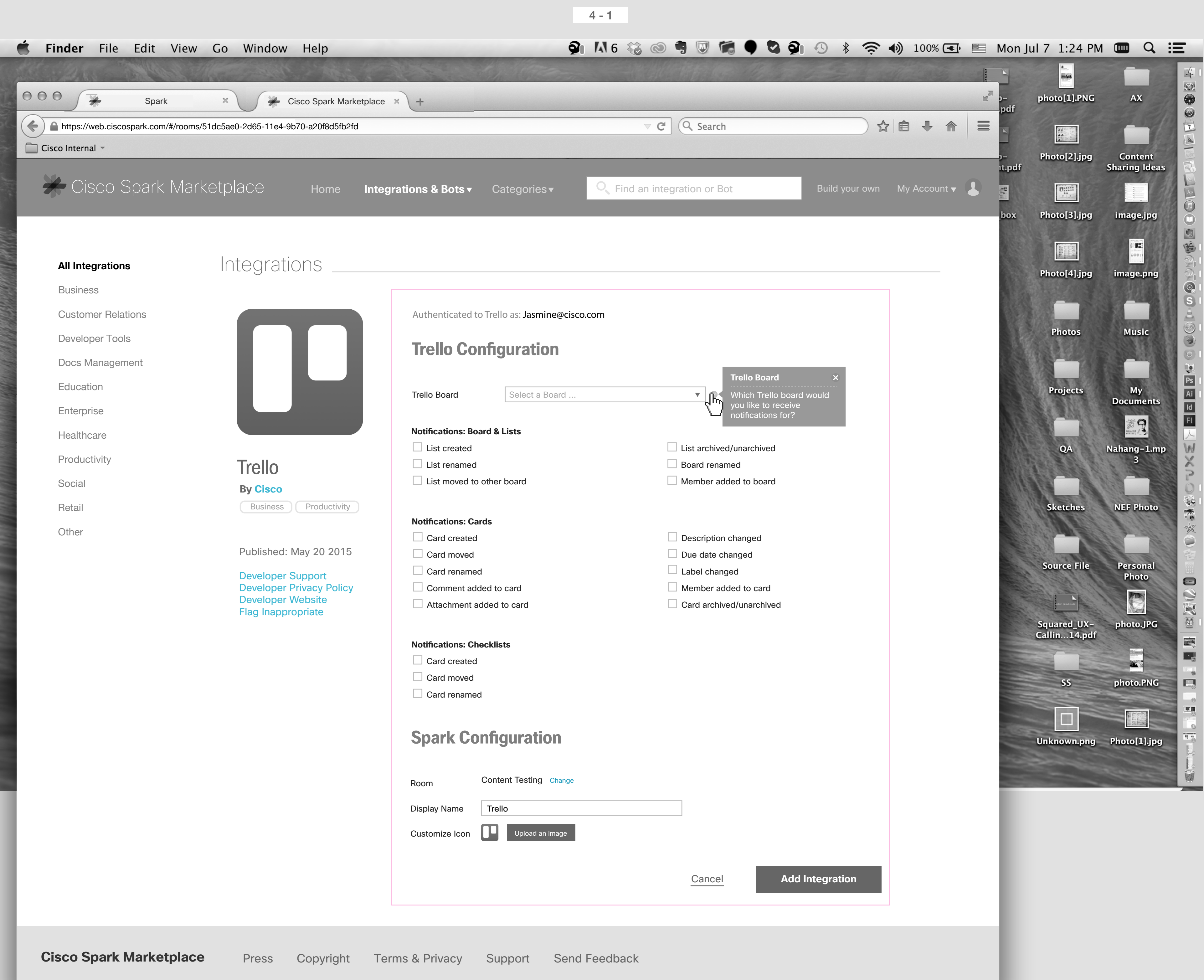
She goes to the Trello detail page. She clicks on the “Connect & Add” button.

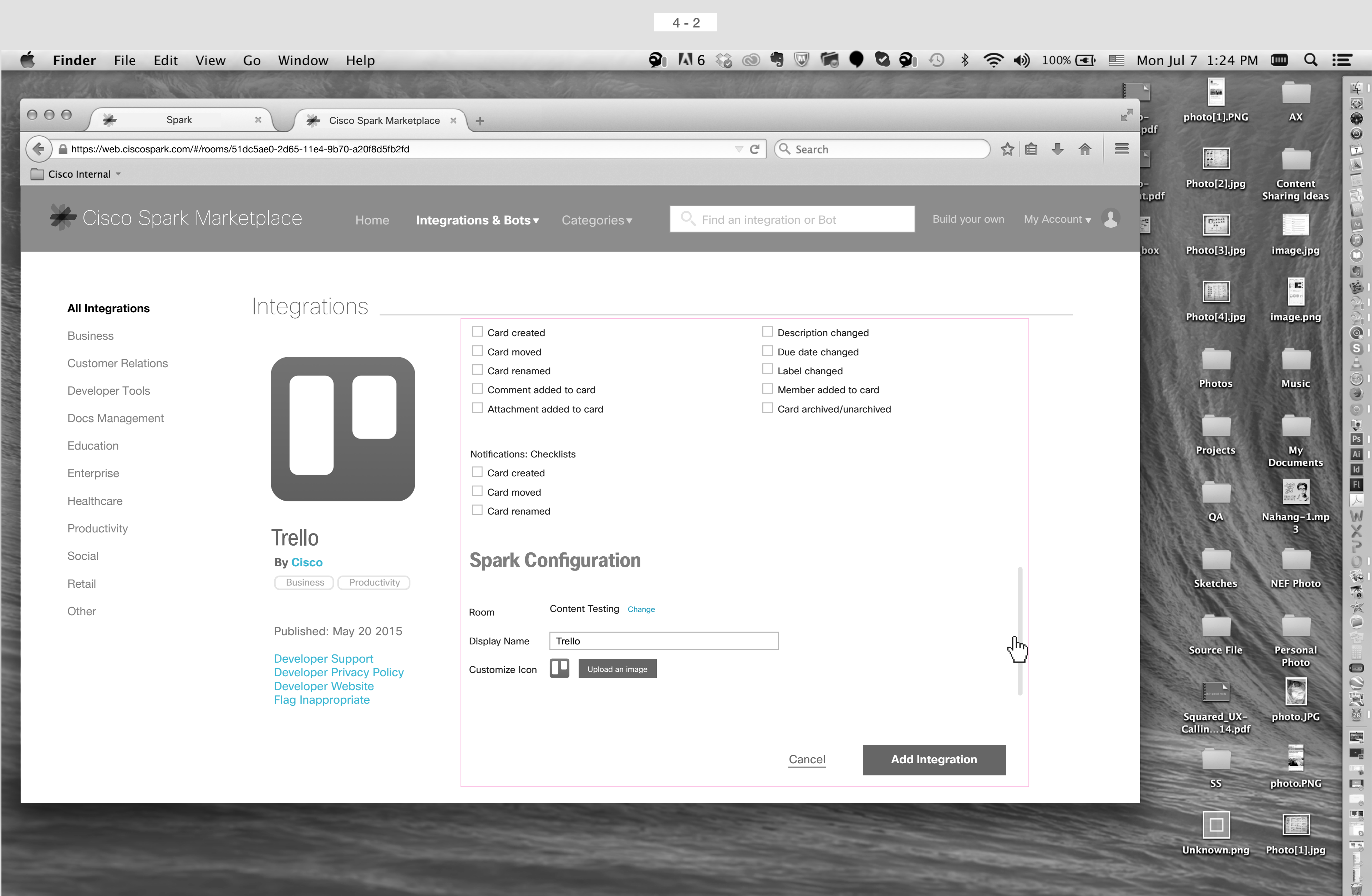

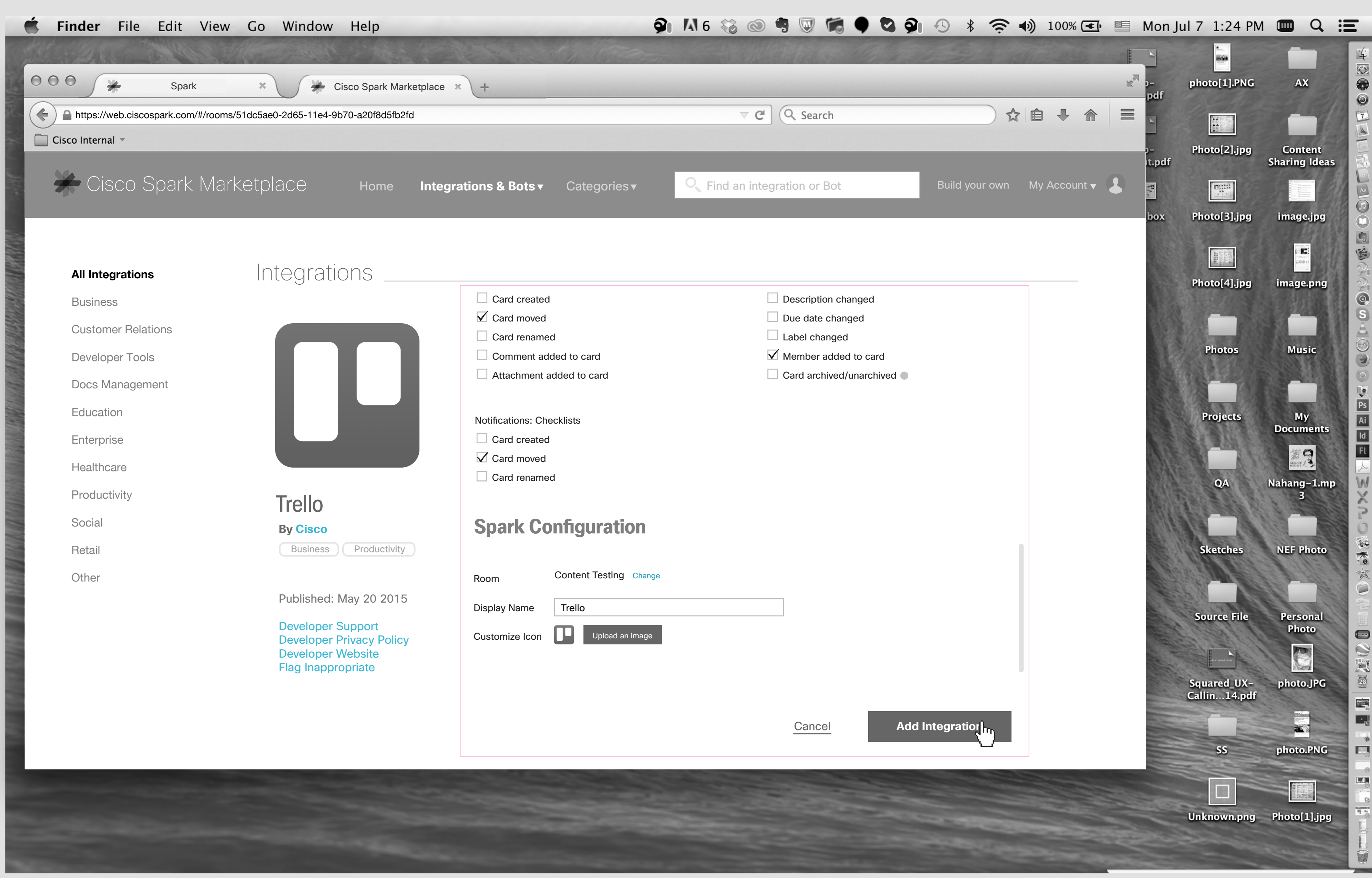
She allows Cisco Spark to use her account on Trello and clicks on “Allow” button.



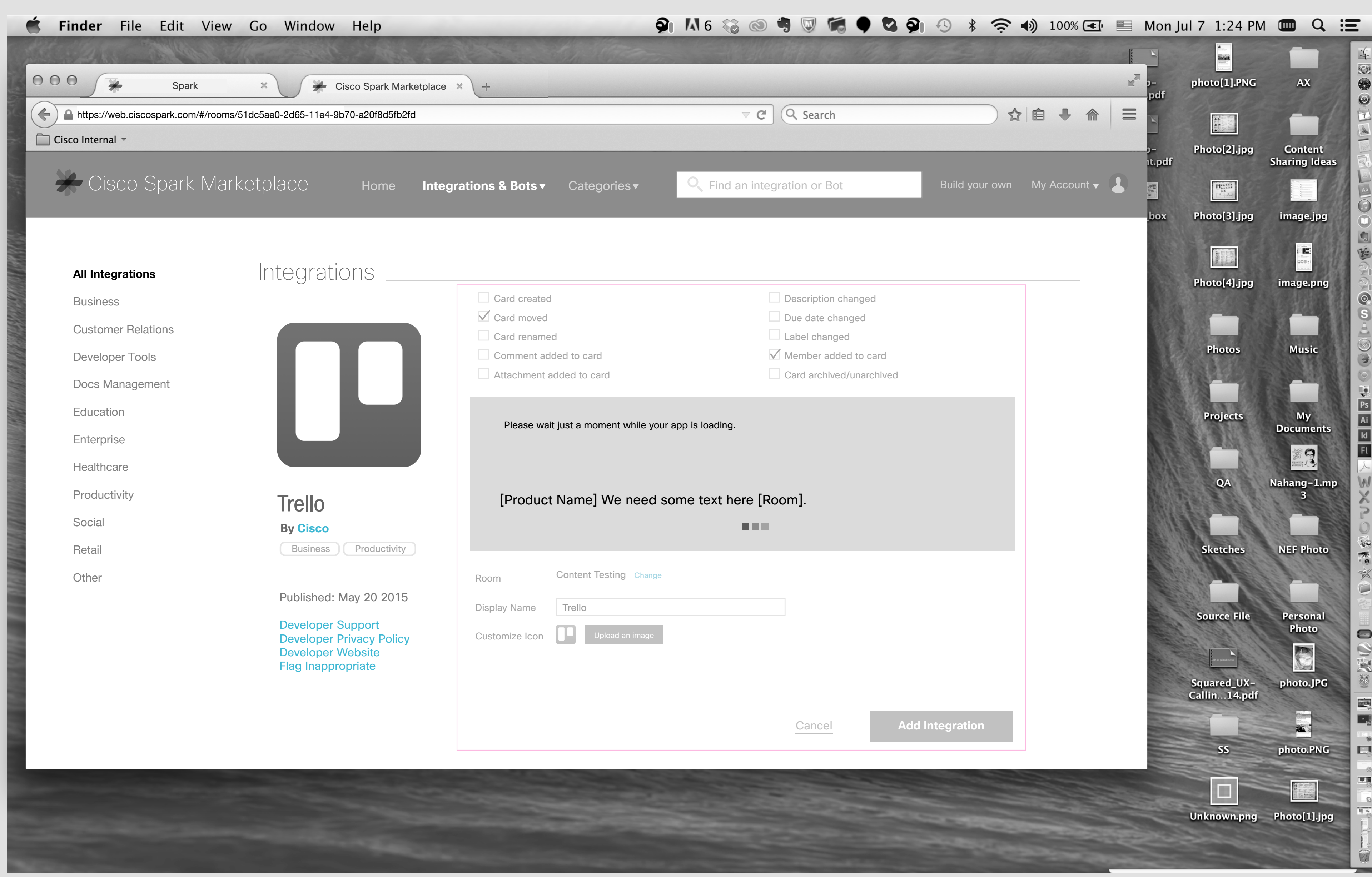
She will be taken to the Trello configuration page,... She mouse over the “?” icon and see more info about that combo box.

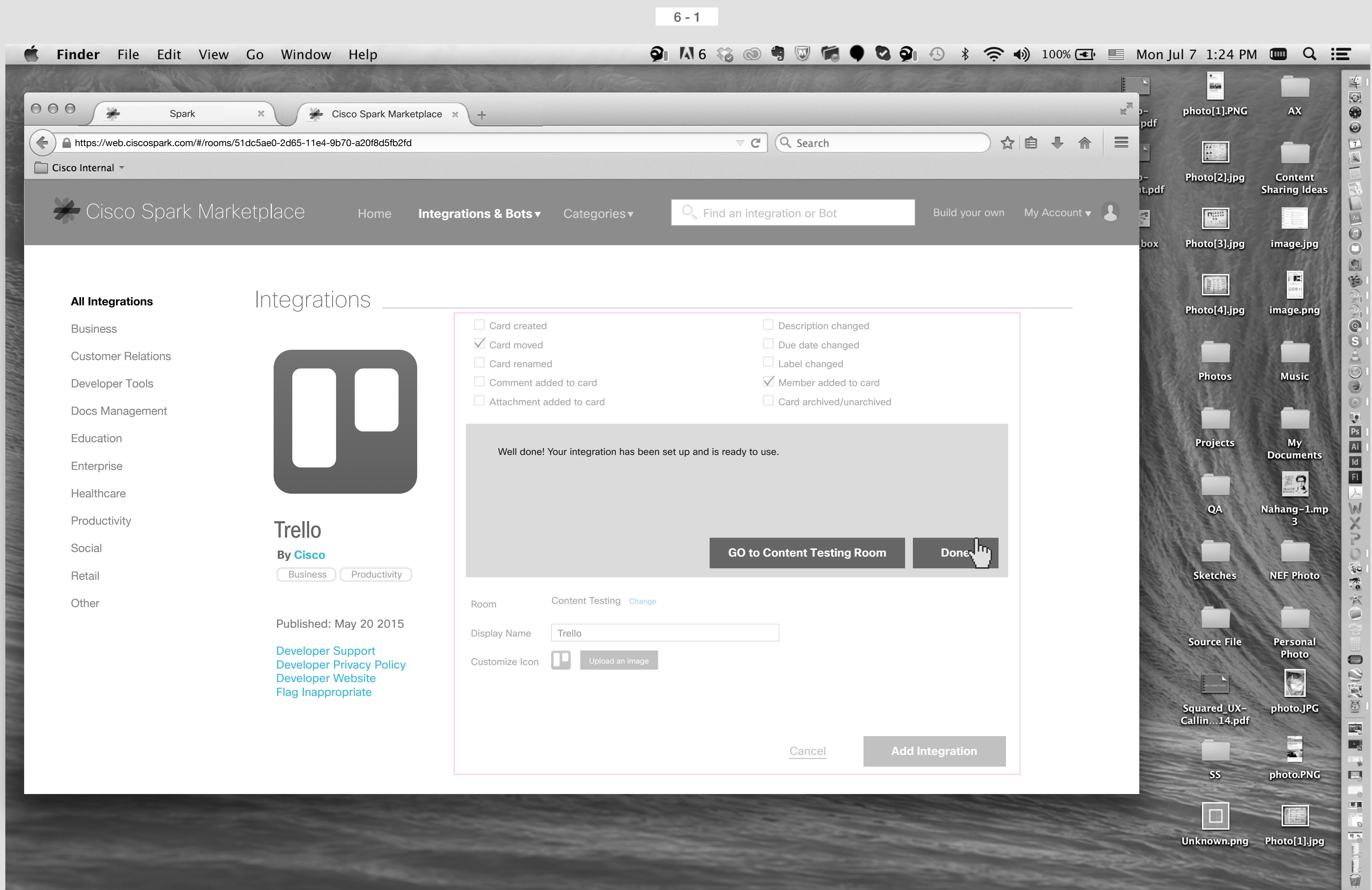
She selects a Board, scroll down the page to see the rest of the page.

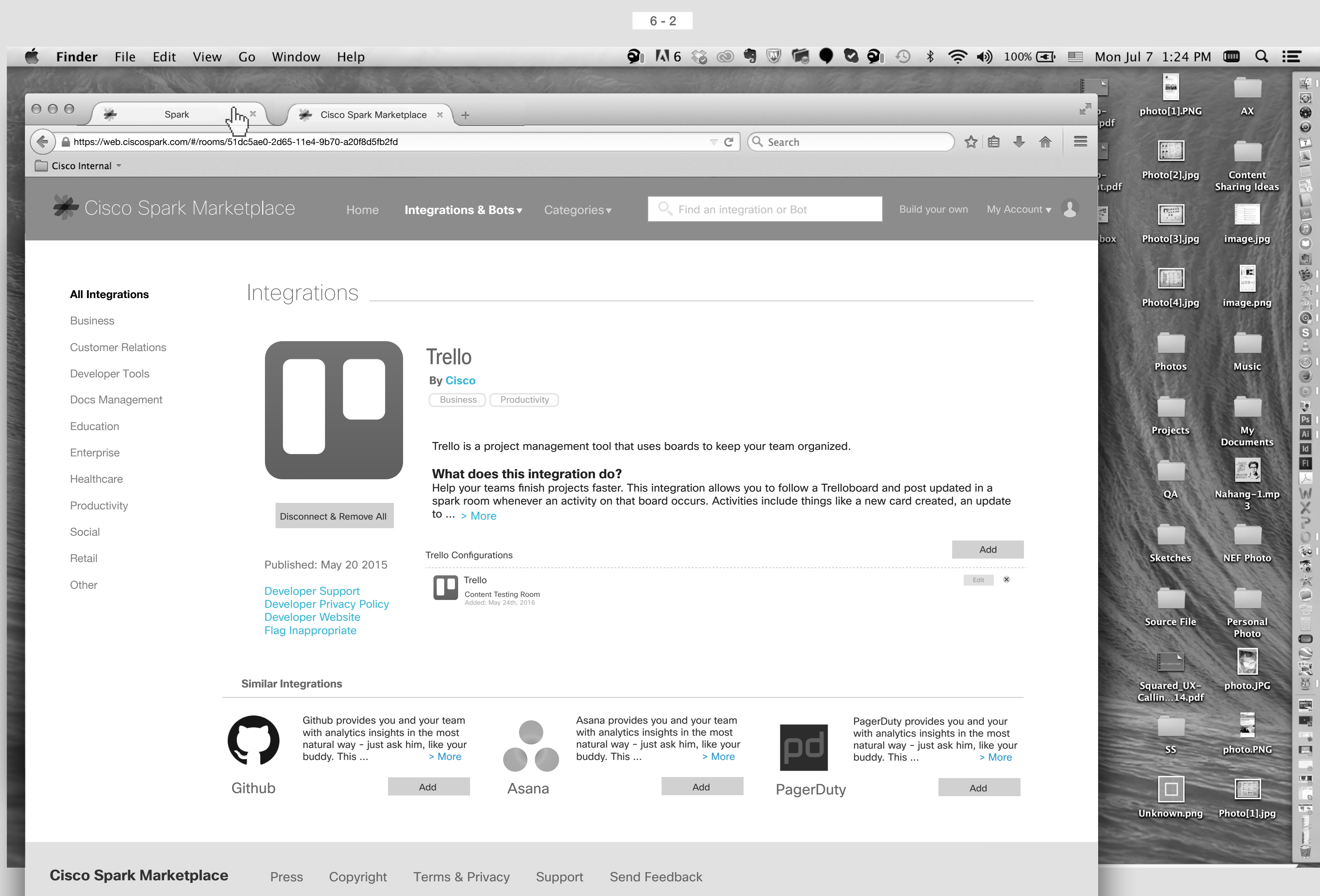
She selects some items from the notification lists and clicks on "Add Integration".

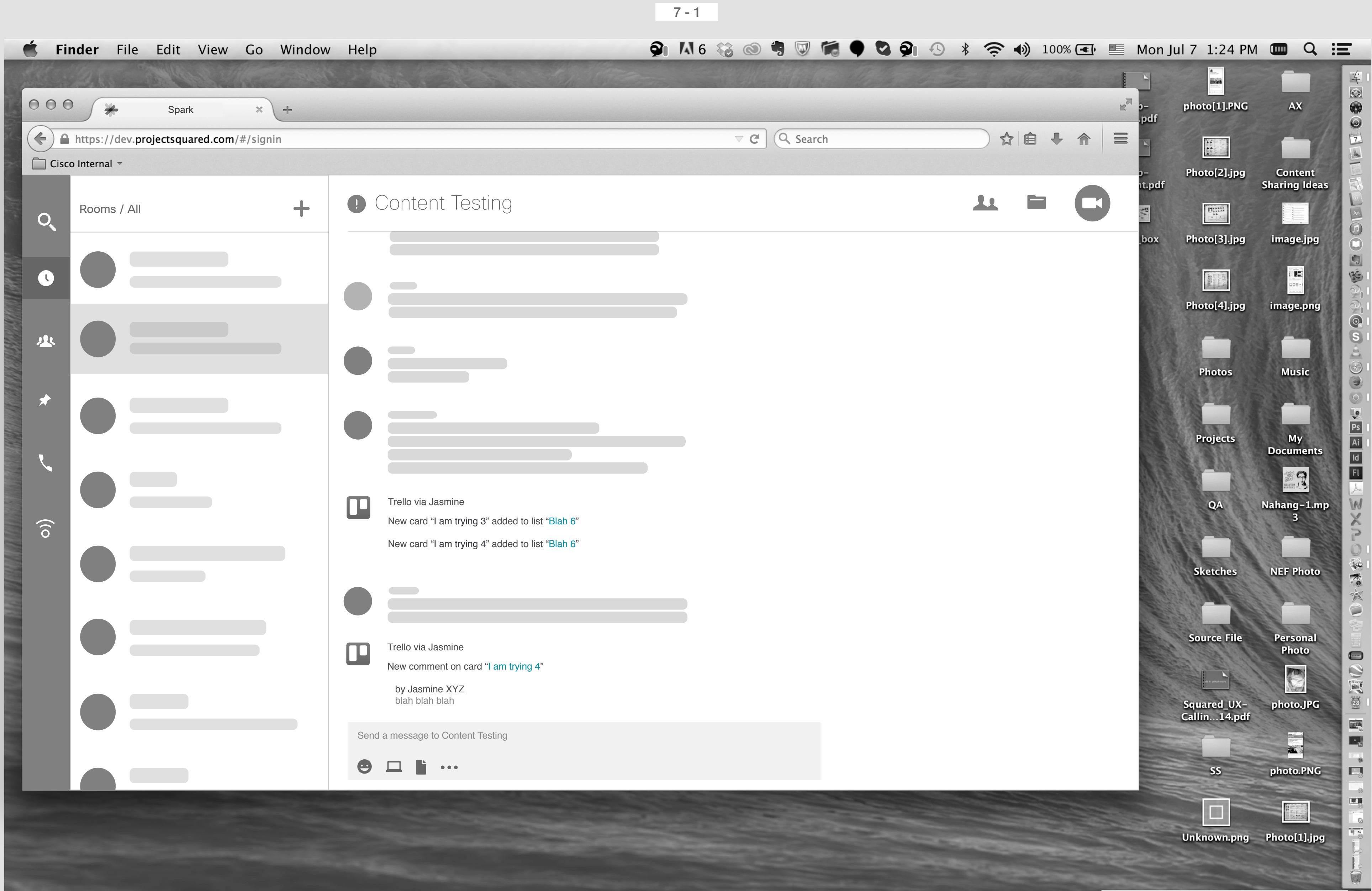
Some loading & confirmation message.

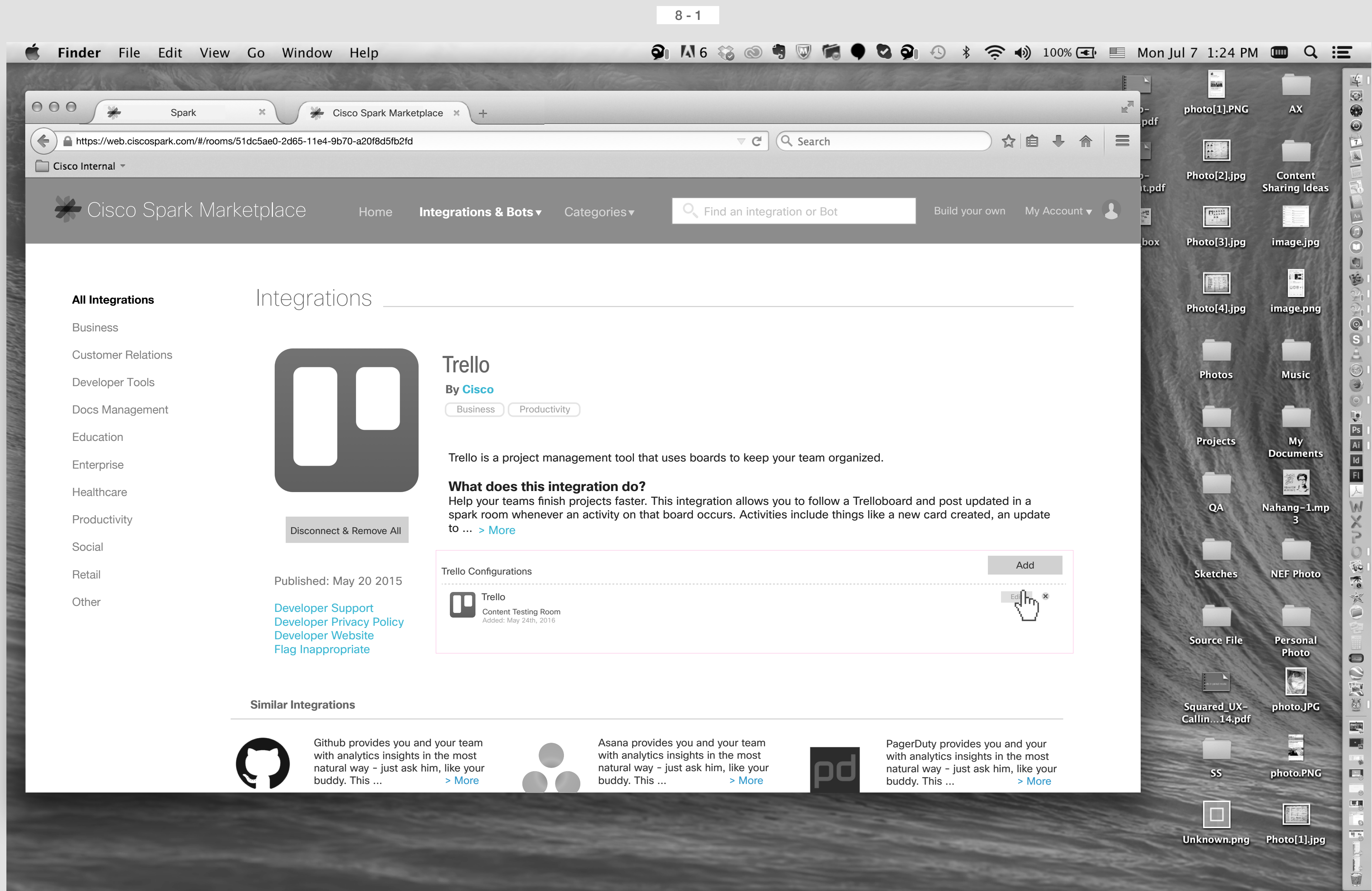

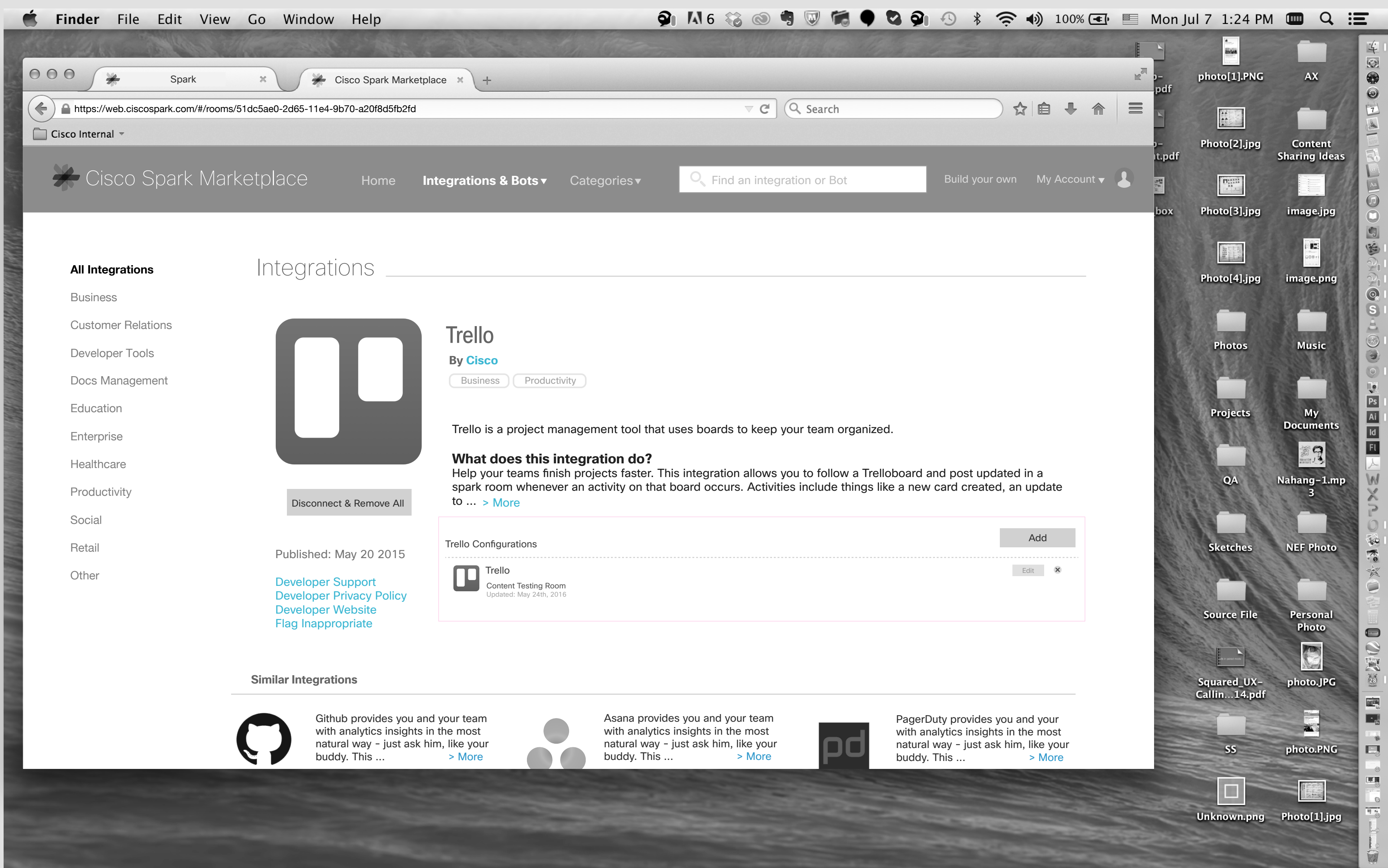

A Remove dialogue box will appear, she clicks on "Remove" button.

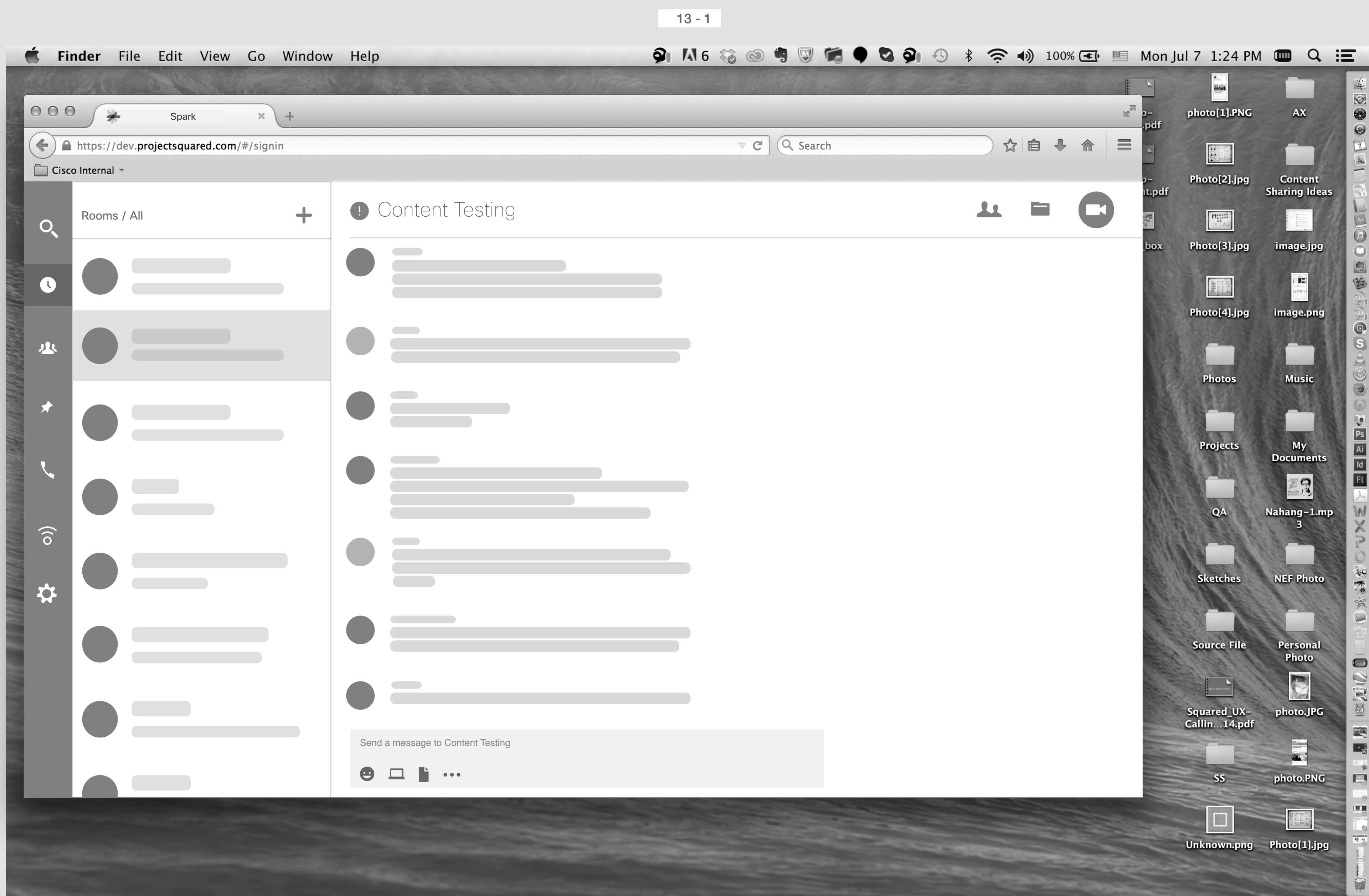


It should show no item on the list of Trello integrations. and Jasmine will see Video & Screenshots.

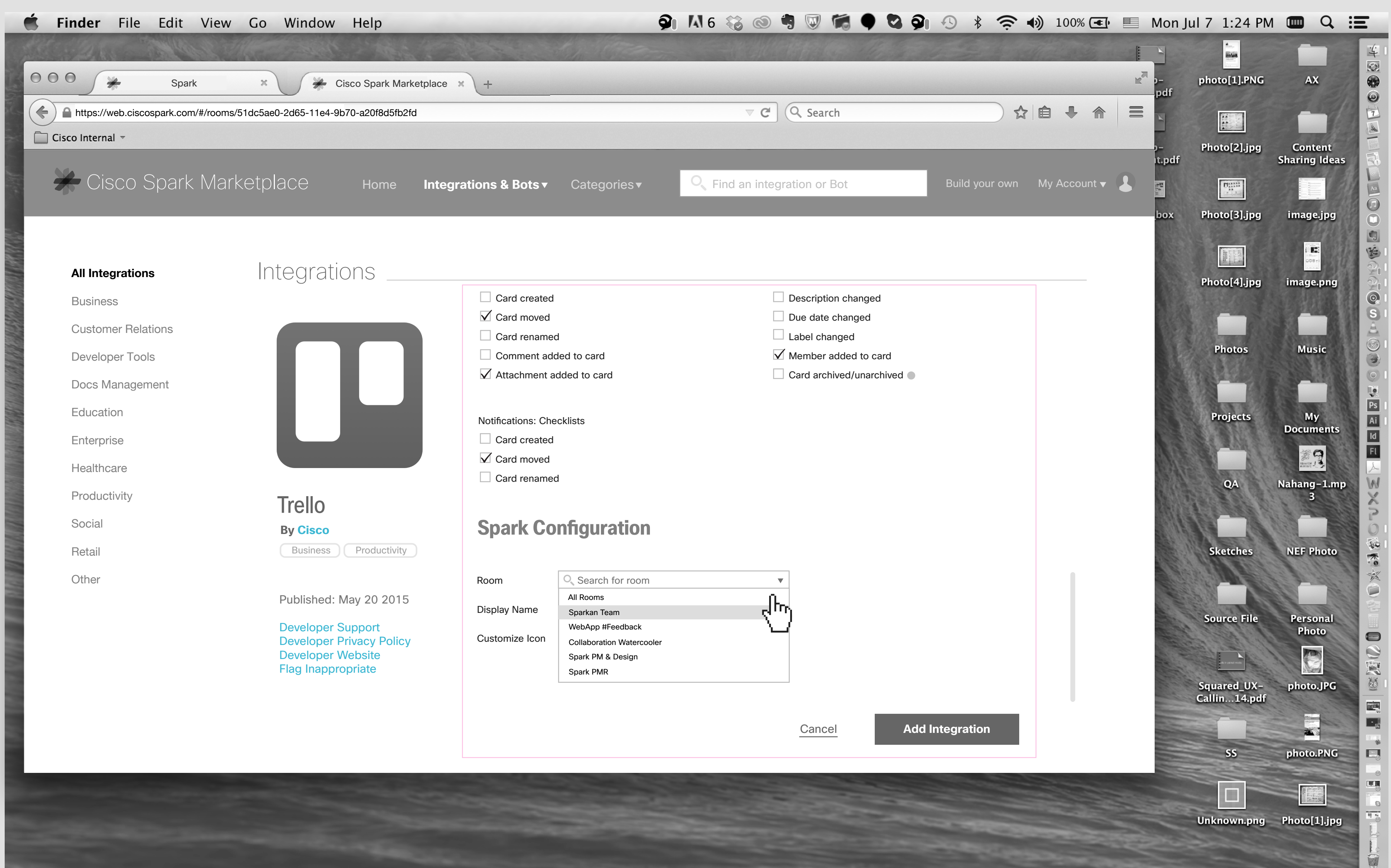

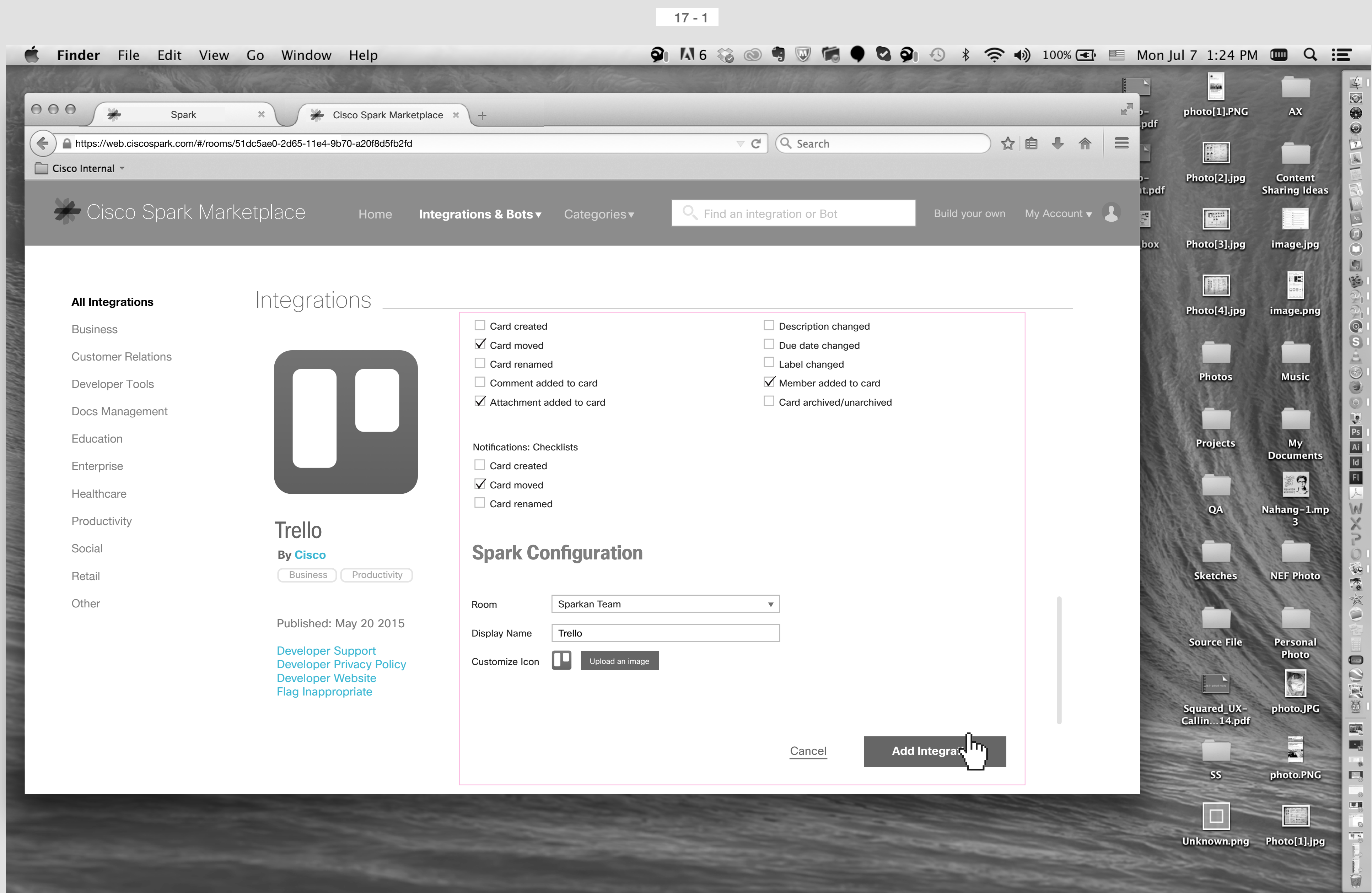

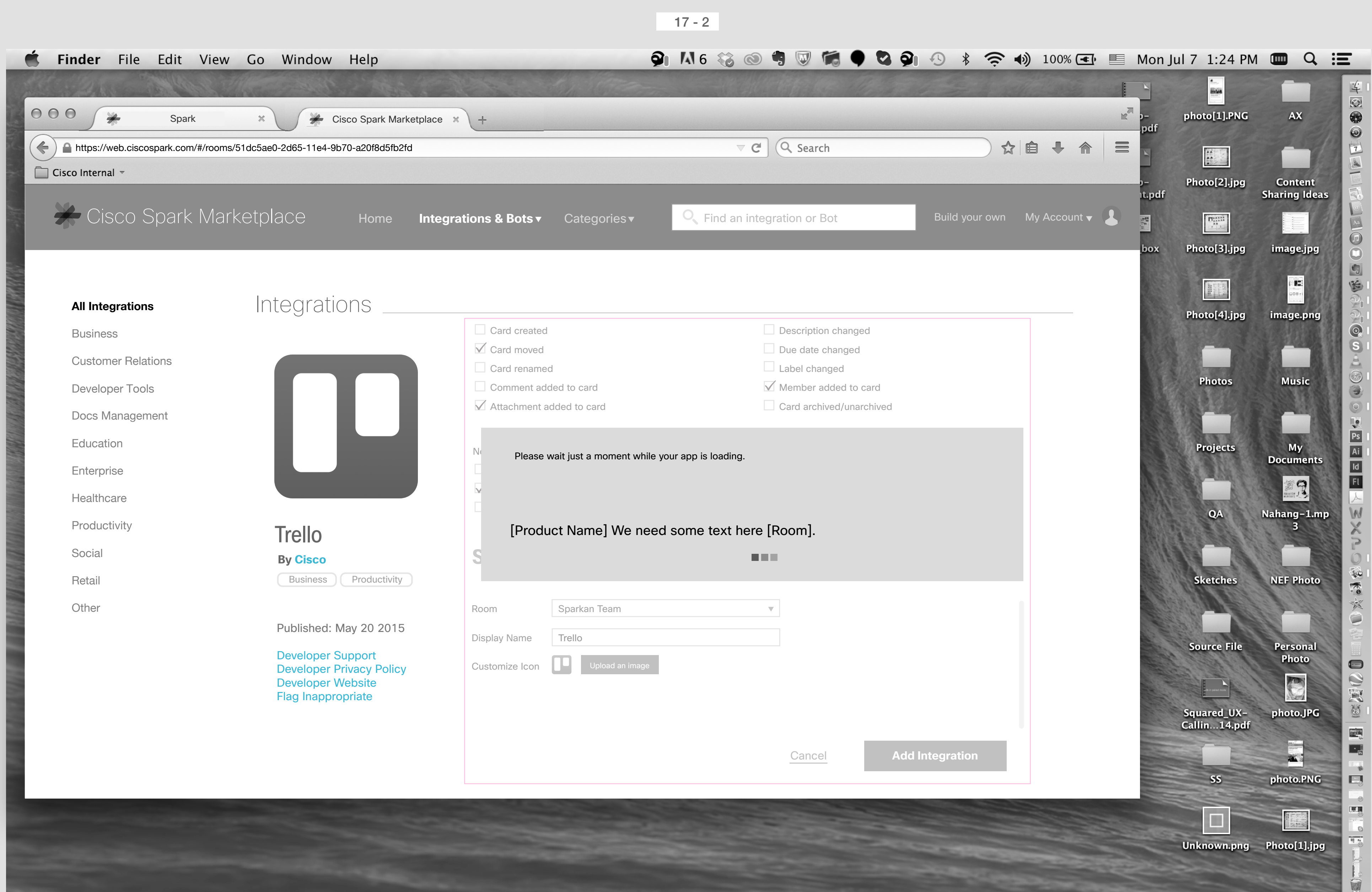


From the list, she select "Sparkan Team" room. User should be able to search for room.

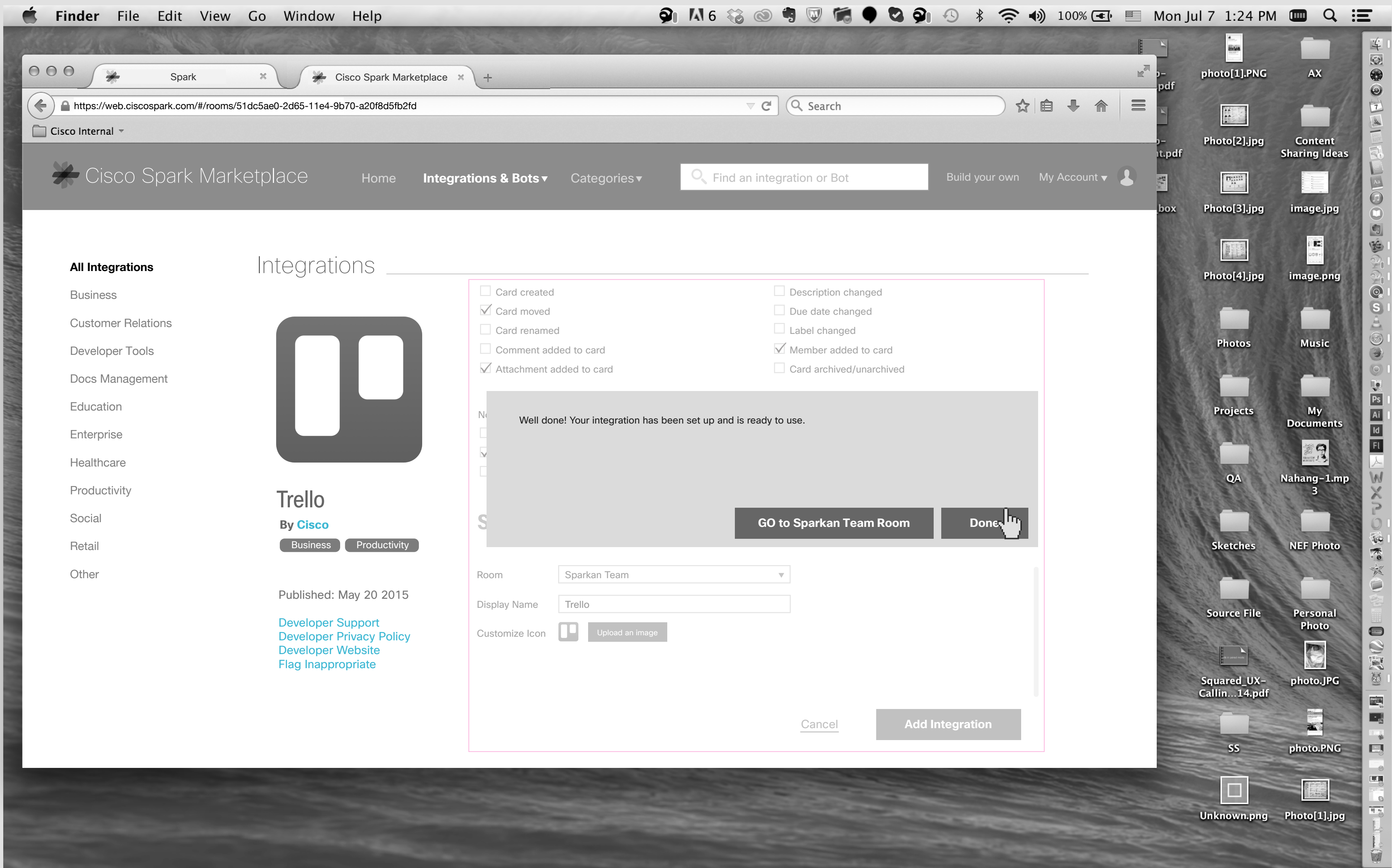

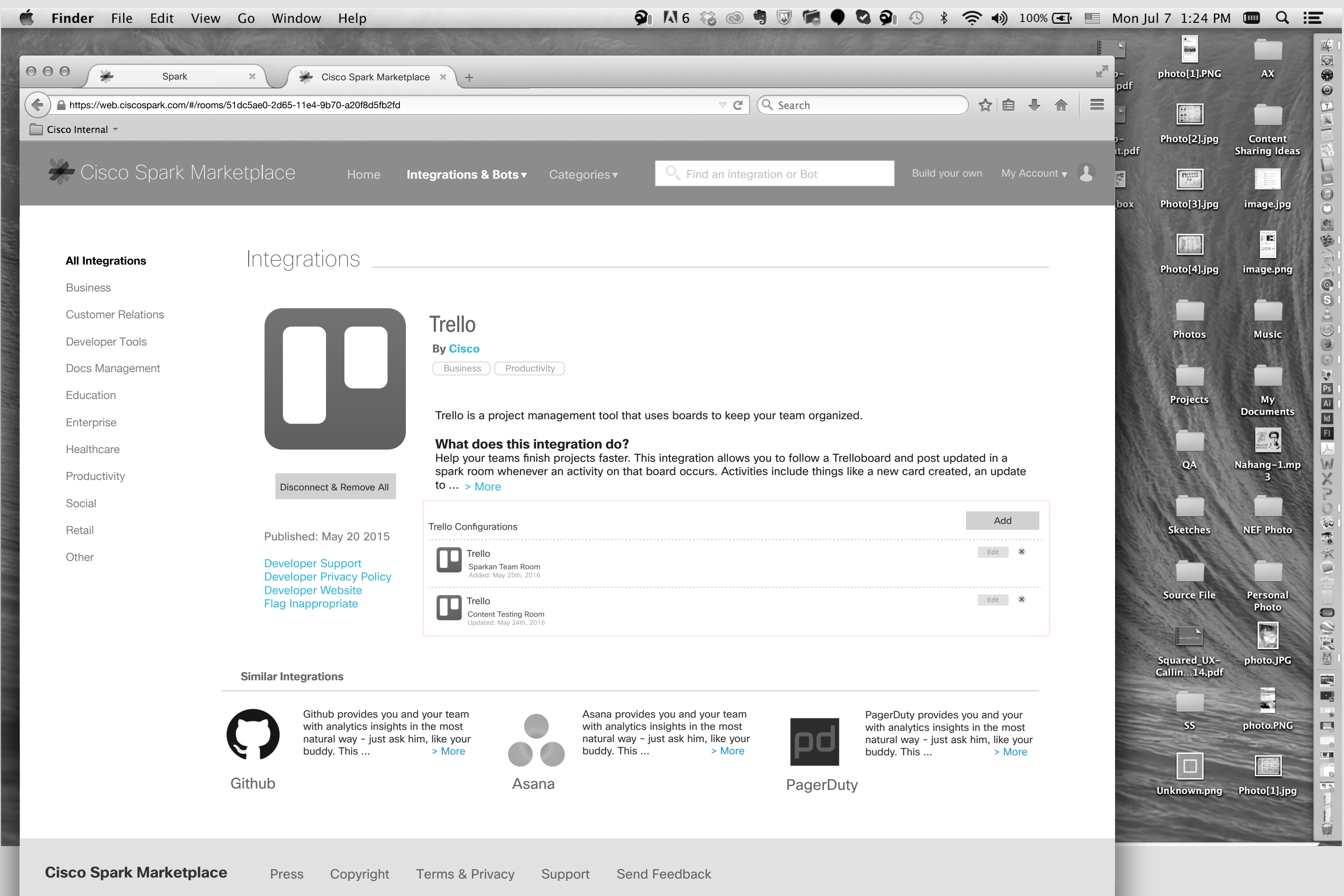

Jasmine clicks on "Integrations & Bots" from the top bar.



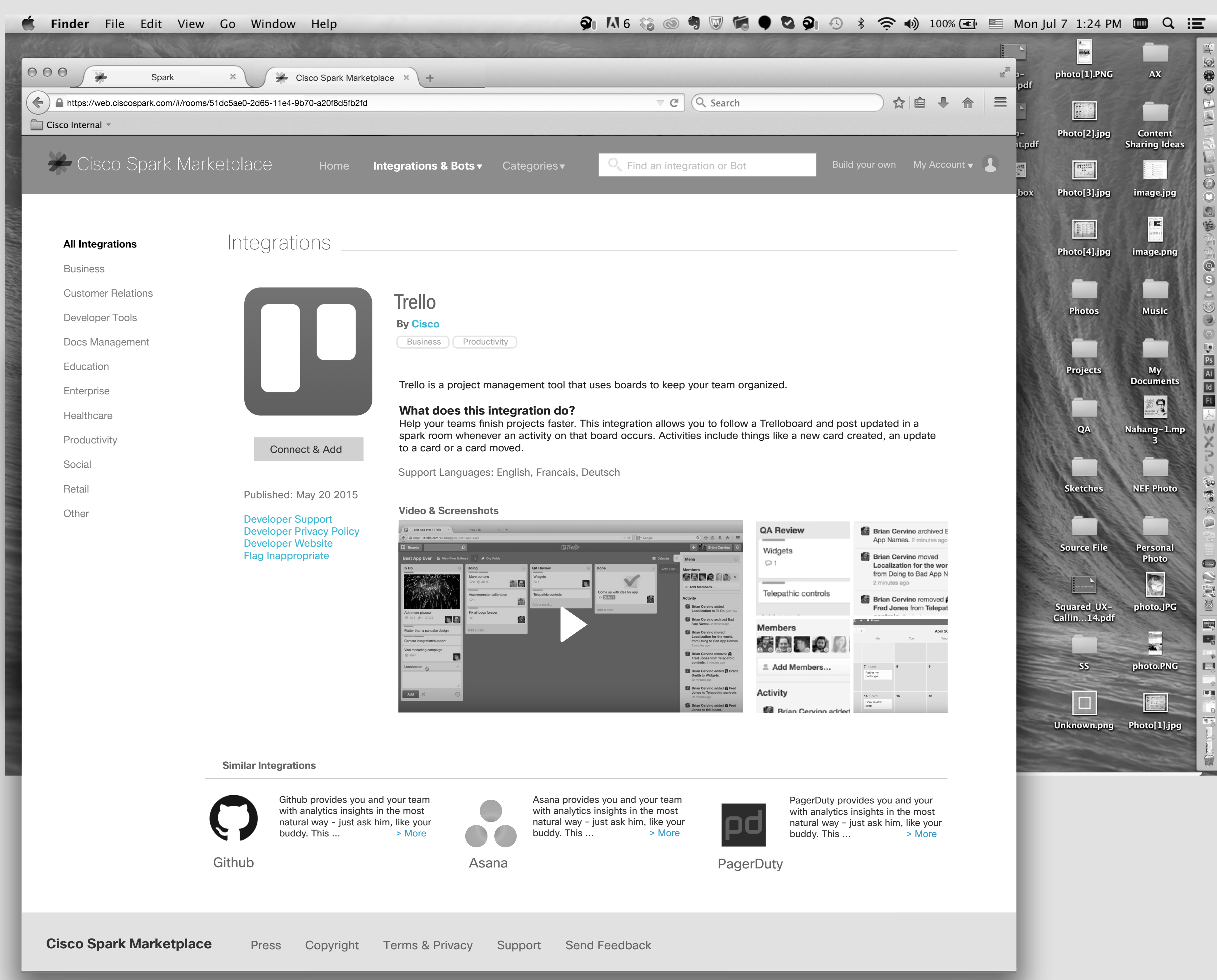
She clicks on "Integrations".

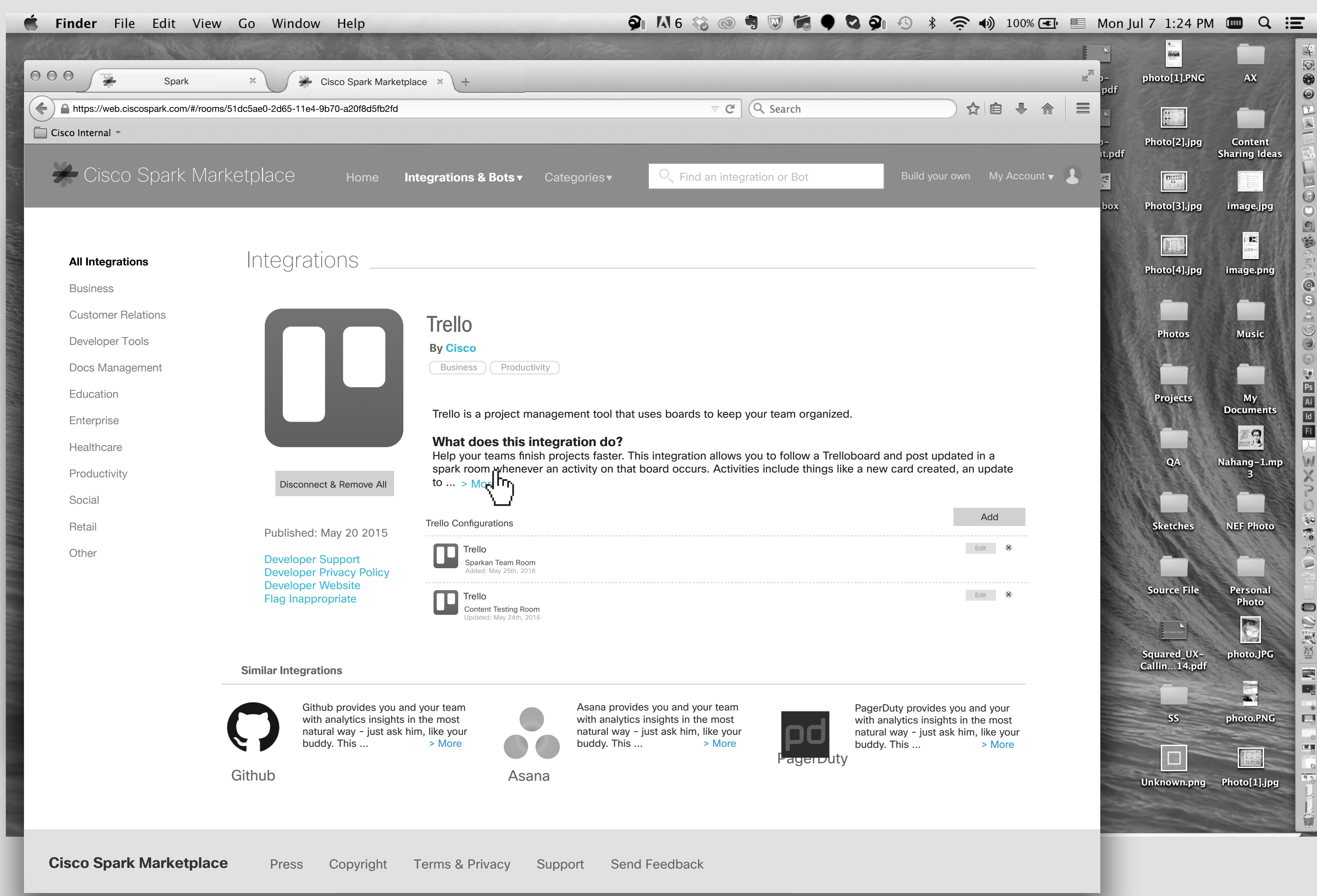

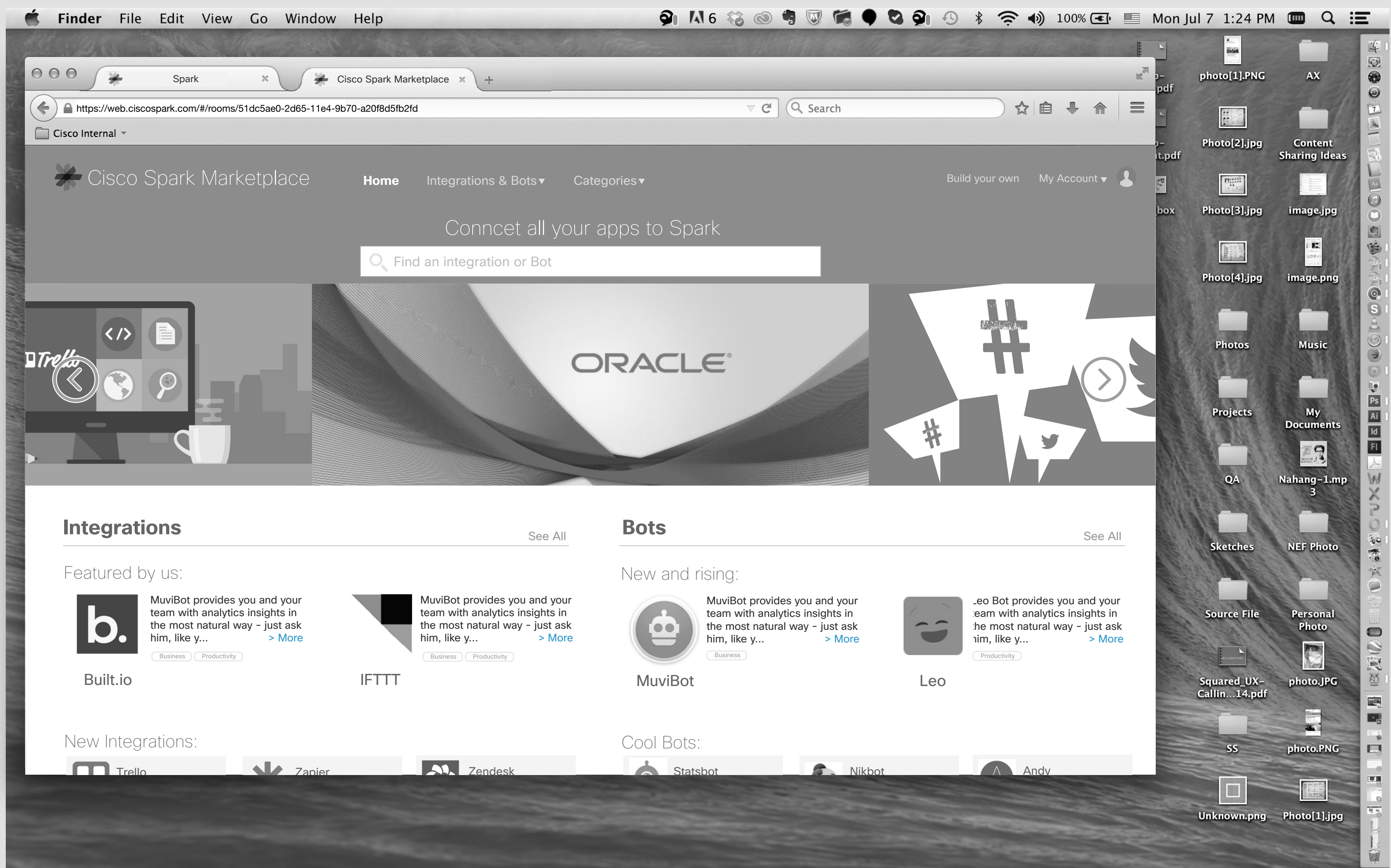

It will take her to Sprk client and will create a room with the Weather Bot. If she already has a room, it will take her to the existing one.

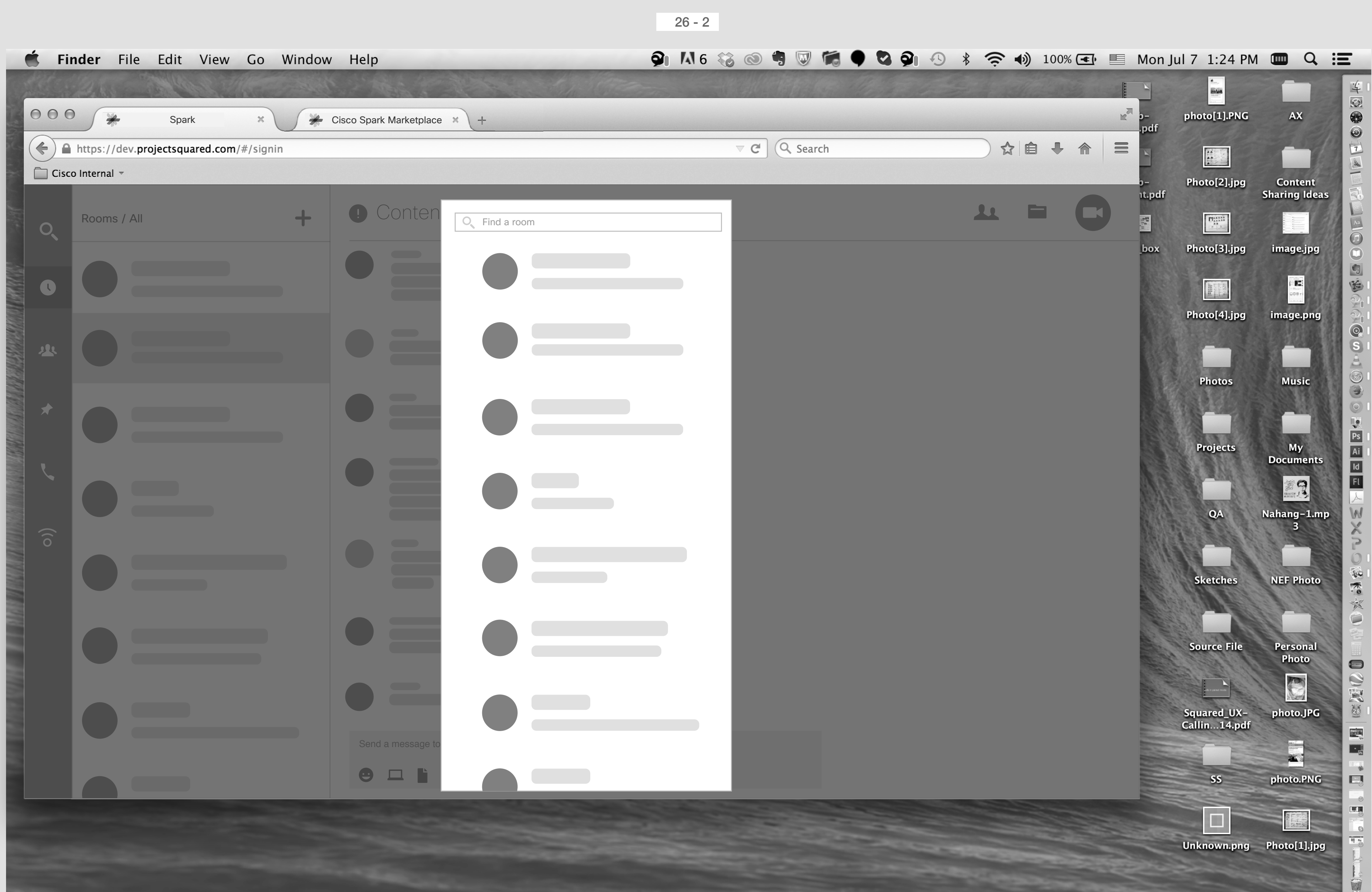

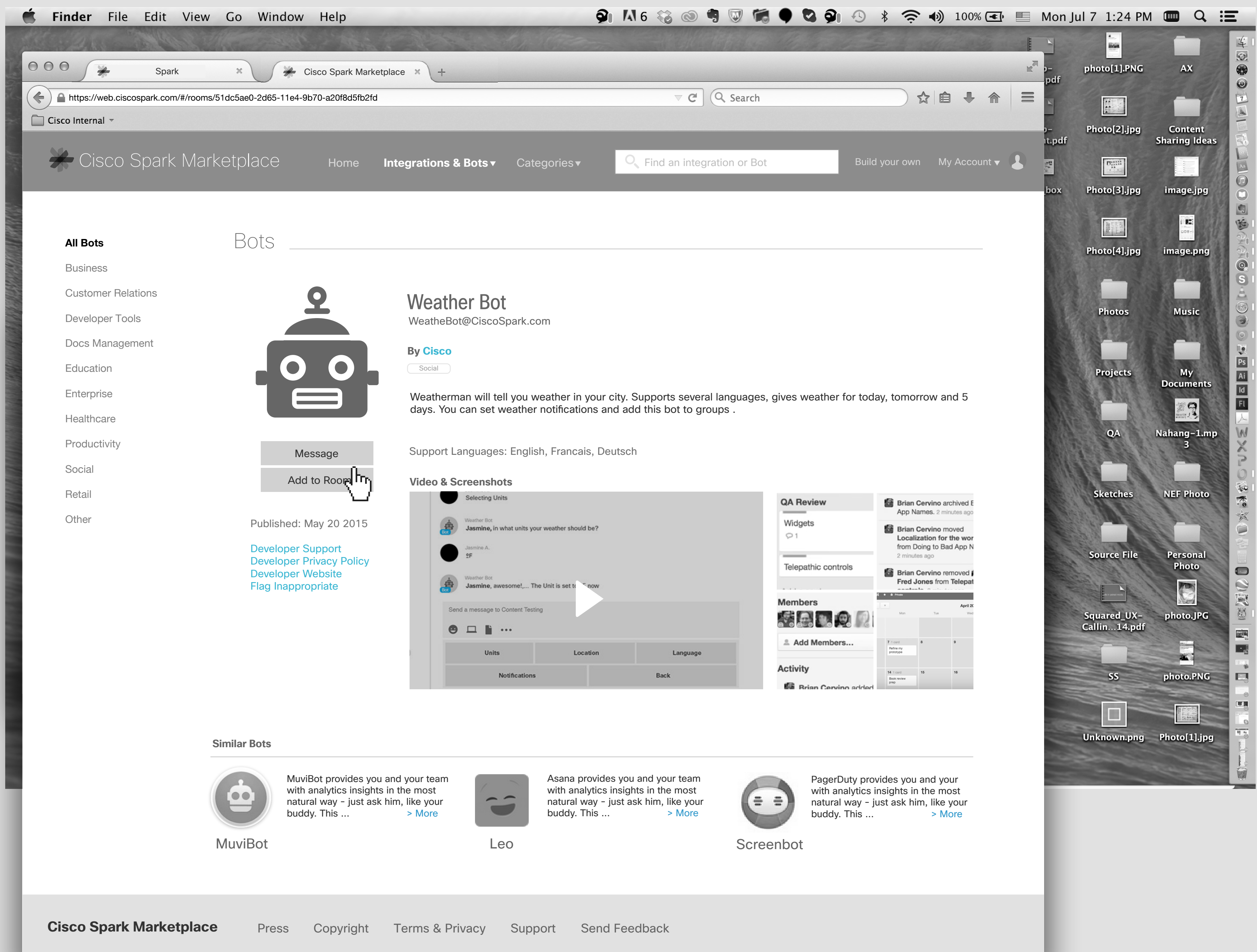


It will take her to the Spark client and she will arrive to this page. She can search for the room or select it from the list.
